WORKING WITH PROGRESSIVES

PREMEASUREMENT CHECKLIST REDO-CHECKLIST

Communicate

- 1. What are they currently wearing
- 2. Are they happy with current pair
- 3. What would they change
- 4. Ask about use, make sure prog. Is ok for their work and hobbies.

Check old progressives

- 1. Dot up laser etchings to verify style And seg-height
- 2. Match previous seg-height or adjust to Patient's preference, use the next steps

Pre-adjust frame

- 1. Nose pad adjustment
- 2. Earpiece conformance
- 3. Pantoscopic tilt and face form
- 4. Ensure enough room for seg-height, 22mm Ideal minimum seg-height, use cut-out chart to double check.

Measure

- 1. Make sure you are eye level, match old Seg-height or adjust to patient's preference. The standard is to dot the center of the patient's pupil. Use a felt tip marker to make a reference point.
- 2. Have the patient look side to side to get multiple head positions.
- 3. Measure from the reference point down into the groove of frame.
- 4. Have the patient put on the glasses to recheck the seg-height.

Communicate

- 1. Ask what difficulties they have
- 2. What do they use glasses for
- 3. What was the previous lens type
- 4. Where is the clearest vision and Where the blurred vision is.

Check Glasses

- 1. Dot up laser etchings
- 2. Check Rx in lensometer
- 3. Check for channel placement (o.c's and channel placement)

Check Frame Adjustment

- 1. Face form and Pantoscopic tilt (10-15 degrees for Panto.)
- 2. Nosepad Adjustment, to ensure Proper seg-height

If everything checks out properly and the patient is still having trouble, have them see the Doctor for a recheck and then send for a Redo.
